It draws on the knowledge and skills of those in the room, augmented by the lesson in the curriculum. Each prospective member must acknowledge the following membership responsibilities:

- **❖** I agree to accept and complete the training required by the MBLI including the time commitments of membership and placement.
- **❖** I agree to attend 8 out of 9 <u>complete</u> sessions. I understand that I will be terminated from the program for not meeting the attendance policy.
- **❖** I agree to be on time for each session. I have received permission from my employer to leave work in time to attend EACH SESSION IN ITS ENTIRETY.
- ❖ I agree to participate fully and engage in each session.
- ❖ I agree to complete the reading assignments as required.
- **❖** I agree to complete an <u>approved</u> Community Transformation Plan that is designed to transform my community. I

understand that I will be terminated from the program for failure to complete the community service requirement.

- ❖ I agree to lead at least one discussion session during the year.
- ❖ I agree to, except for emergency, give the Institute staff at least 48 hours notice of my absence.
