Attendance and Work Commitment – The Leadership Institute convenes one weekend each month (typically Saturday) for 9 consecutive months. The sessions focus on developing the community leadership capacity of individuals. The training emphasizes an interactive and facilitative style rather than lectures. It draws on the knowledge and skills of those in the room, augmented by the lesson in the curriculum. Each prospective member must acknowledge the following membership responsibilities:

- ❖ **I agree to accept and complete the training required by the MBLI including the time commitments of membership and placement.**
- ❖ **I agree to attend 8 out of 9 complete sessions. I understand that I will be terminated from the program for not meeting the attendance policy.**
- ❖ **I agree to be on time for each session. I have received permission from my employer to leave work in time to attend EACH SESSION IN ITS ENTIRETY.**
- ❖ **I agree to participate fully and engage in each session.**
- ❖ **I agree to complete the reading assignments as required.**
- ❖ **I agree to complete an approved Community Transformation Plan that is designed to transform my community.**
- ❖ **I understand that I will be terminated from the program for failure to complete the community service requirement.**
- ❖ **I agree to lead at least one discussion session during the year.**
- ❖ **I agree to, except for emergency, give the Institute staff at least 48 hours notice of my absence.**
- ❖ **I understand that I will be terminated from the program for committing fraud upon the Institute.**
